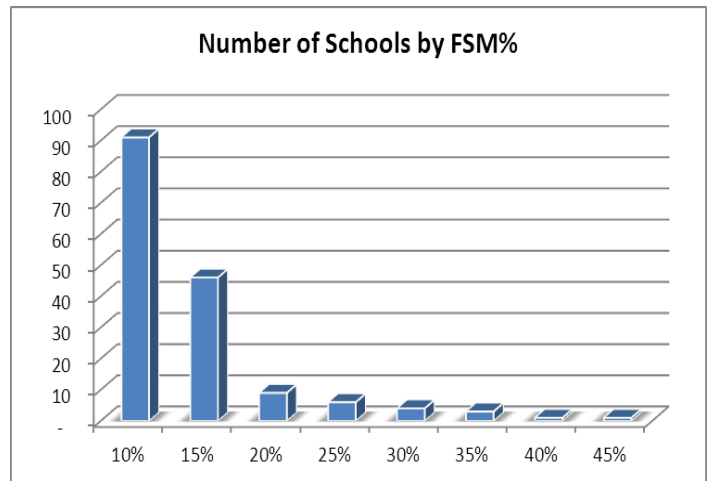


Context

31%(2011)

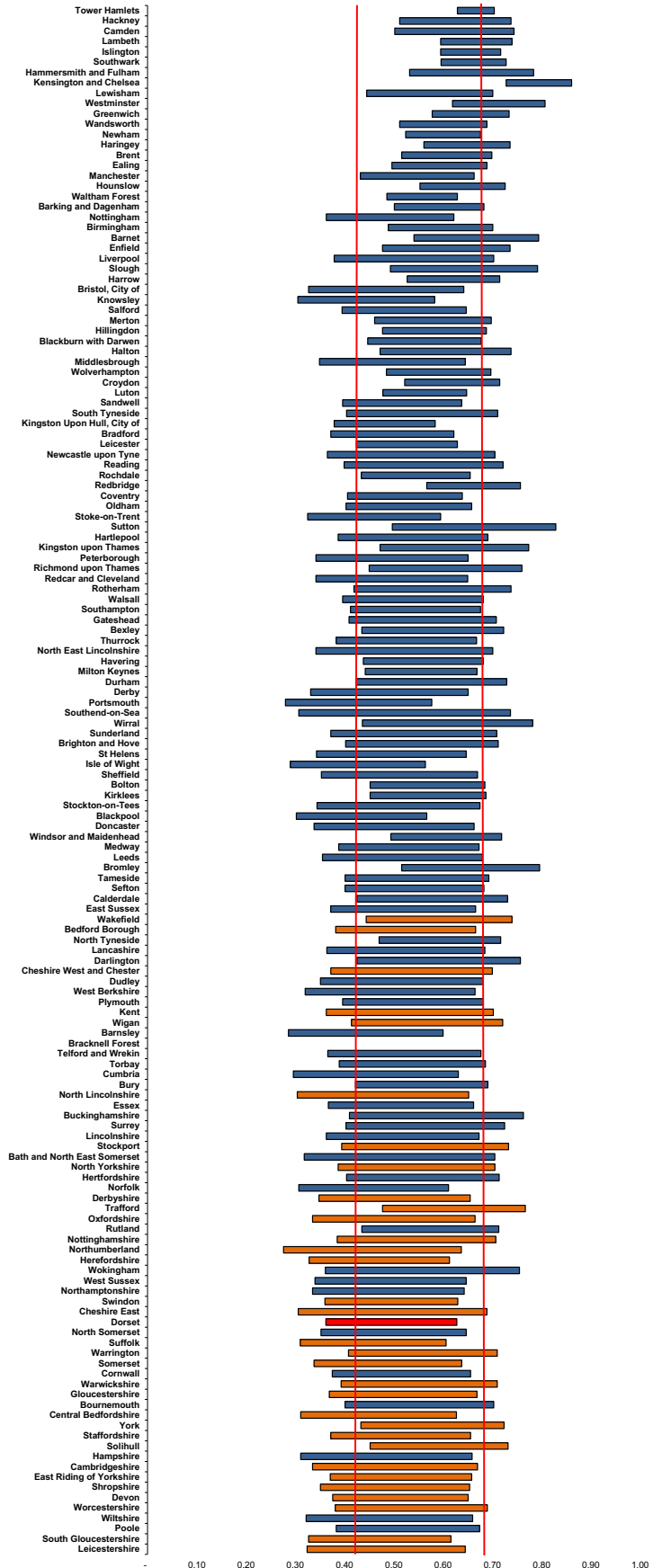
